The Zebra-shaped front gate on Ratuszowa Street, made of bent metal, was designed by architect Bogdan Kulczyński in the 1980s; it opens to the Main Alley, renovated in 2017. Aviaries situated along right side of the alley were built during the Interwar Period, and previously housed ravens, starlings, blackbirds. Today they are inhabited by raptors and the largest one of them – by ibises.
